

# Grant Funded Aspirant Headteachers Programme for Women into Secondary Leadership Men into Primary Leadership

The Aspirant Headteachers Programme is an innovative 6 face to face session programme, delivered by current headteachers and senior leaders, supported by business directors, a National Leader of Governance (NLG) and senior leaders. It is aimed at senior and experienced middle leaders who aspire to senior leadership and headship. This course is appropriate for school leaders planning to seek next stage promotion over the next 12-18 months.

- Leading the organisation - moral imperative, vision, innovation in the curriculum (full day)
- Using data and closing the gap (4-6pm)
- Finance, legislation and policy - the school as a business (4-6pm)
- Leading teaching and learning, appraisal and capability (full day)
- Applying for headship and working with governors (4-6pm)
- The first term in headship (4-6pm)



The sessions will be delivered centrally within Staffordshire.

The programme will include opportunities to discuss leadership practice with colleagues.

Participants will be required to have a coach, which is usually their own headteacher or headteacher in a partner school. The coach should discuss the implications of the face to face sessions with the participant and explore their reflections. The coach will also explore people management and relationships. There will also be opportunities to visit other schools involved in this programme.

The cost of this programme is normally £750 +VAT—bursaries are available to cover the full cost of this programme under the equality and diversity grant funding from the National College for Teaching and Leadership.

The AHP is run over 7-8 months.
